Policies and Procedures

Membership commitment overview:

*Members are required to:

1. Meet financial obligations of dues ticket sales and donations. (See insert).
2. Sing all scheduled concerts.
3. Women must purchase the MMC concert dress.
4. Men must have a tuxedo and purchase Chorale cummerbund and tie.
5. Attend rehearsals and sectionals.
6. Abide by the policies as set forth in the regular MMC Membership Handbook.

Following are the condensed guidelines for the above:

*Financial Obligations:

- Pay annual dues as set by the Chorale Board.

- Pay refundable sheet music deposit of \$30.
- Sell at least 10 concert tickets
- Donate an auction item for the annual Fundraiser.
- Donate 10 service hours and/or donate \$100

- **Sectional rehearsals** are on Monday nights, 6:45 p.m. to 7:15 p.m. except for the 2nd Monday of the month.
